1900 - 25 people

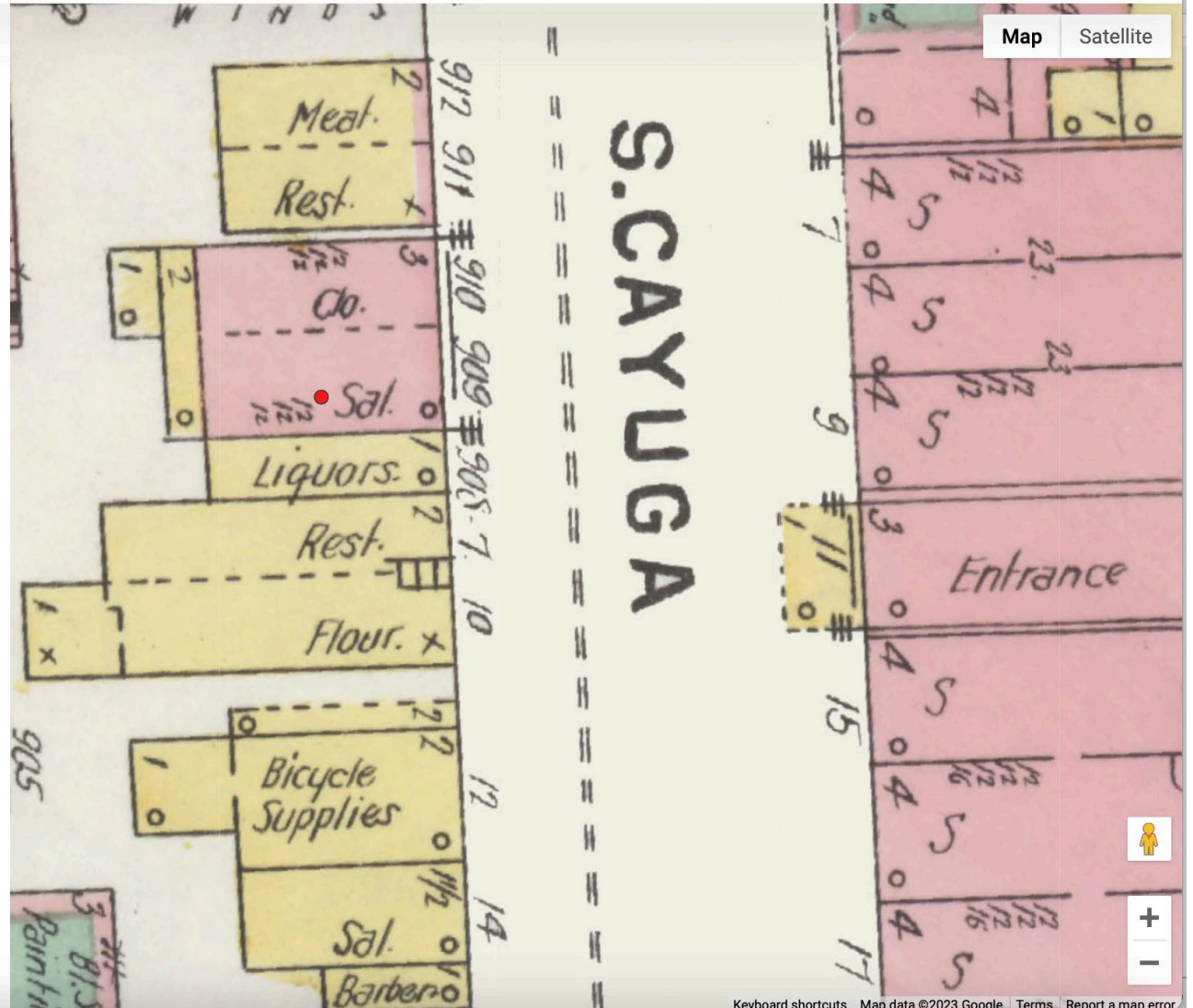

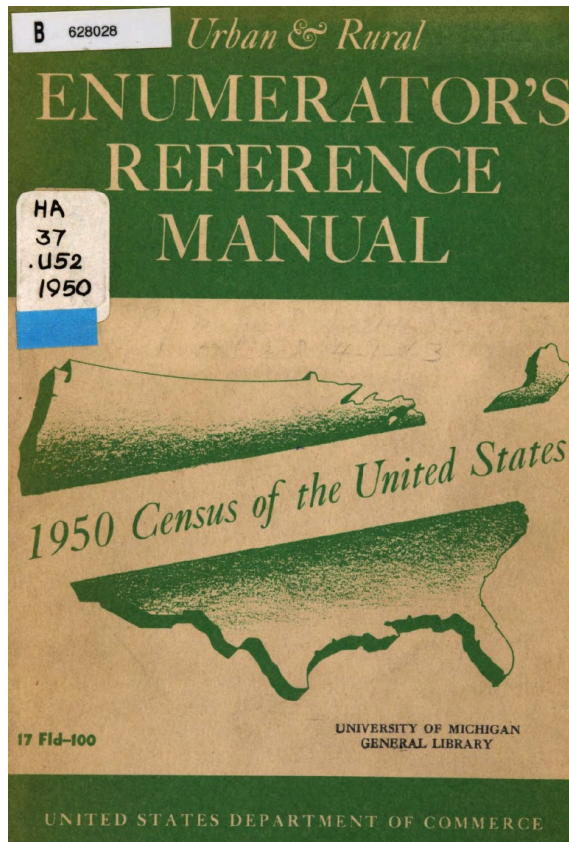


# 1920 Clock System Map

# 1950 Census Enumerator's Instructions



## Household Identification

### Item 1. Street, avenue, or road

**90. Item 1. Entering the street, avenue, or road.**—In a city, write lengthwise in item 1 the name of the street, avenue, court, place, alley, or road on which the structure faces. Where there is no street name, describe fully in the “Notes” section the location of the house in such a way that someone else will be able to find it.

In a town with street names but not numbers, write the name of the street and give location by direction from intersection with another street. For example: Douglas Avenue, west of Sherman.

In a rural area, write the name of the road and give location by direction from intersection with another road. For example: Jones Road, north of U. S. Route 213.

When you go from one street or road to another, draw a horizontal line across the first column. This will show which houses are located on each street or road.

### Item 2. House (and apartment) number

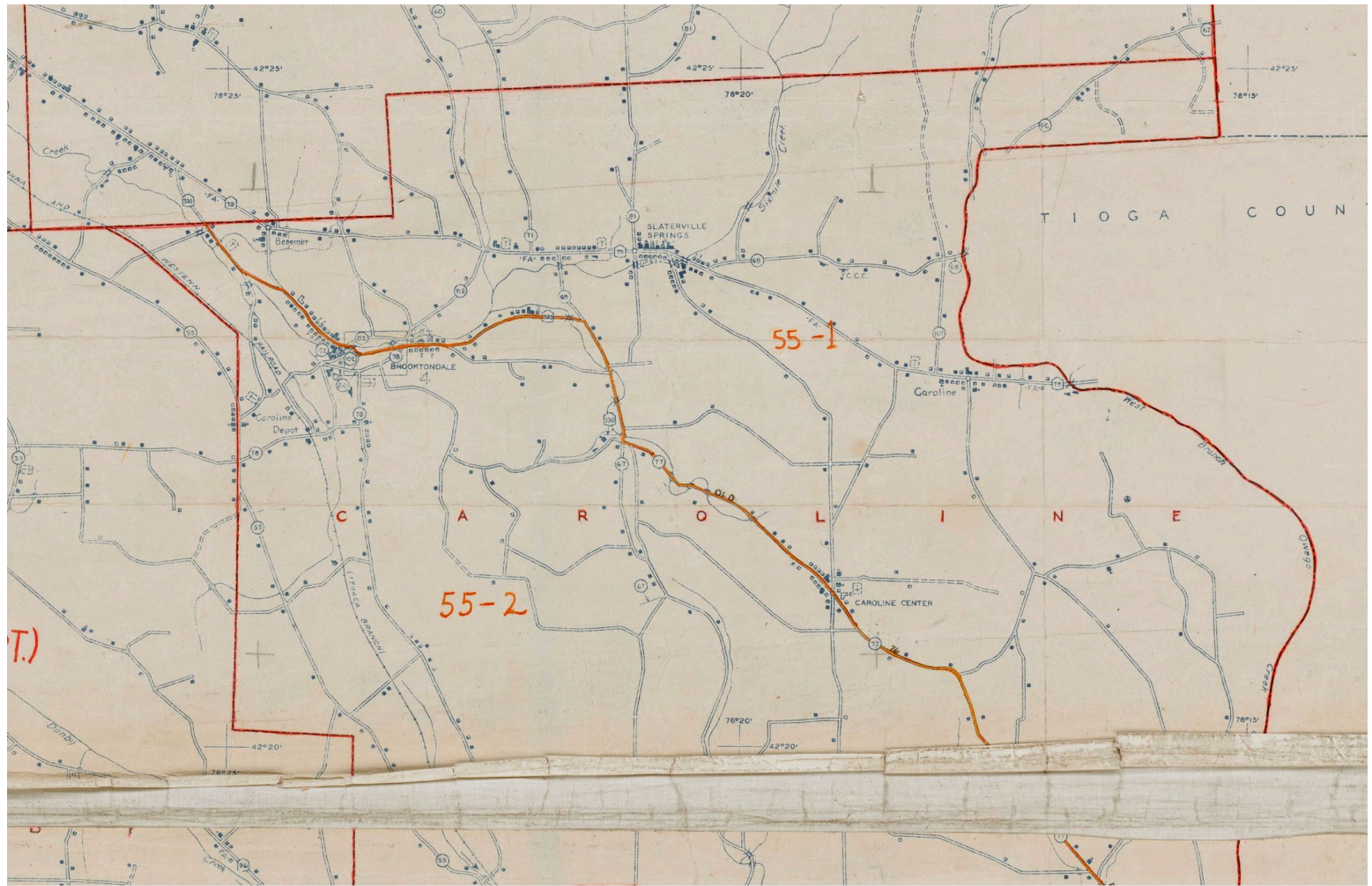
**91. Item 2. Entering the house (and apartment) number.**—Enter the house number, if there is one, on the first line used for the dwelling unit, i. e., the same line on which you list the head of the household. If you are in a house with more than one dwelling unit, enter (in addition to the house number) the apartment number or location. For example: “Apt. 1” or “3rd floor rear.” If a house at the rear of another has no number of its own, give it the same number as the house in front and add the words “rear of,” thus, “rear of 211.” If there is no house number describe its location in such a way that someone else will be able to find the house. For example: “1st house on right after fire house.”

**92. One entry for each household.**—Entries are to be made in items 2 to 6 only on the first line used for the

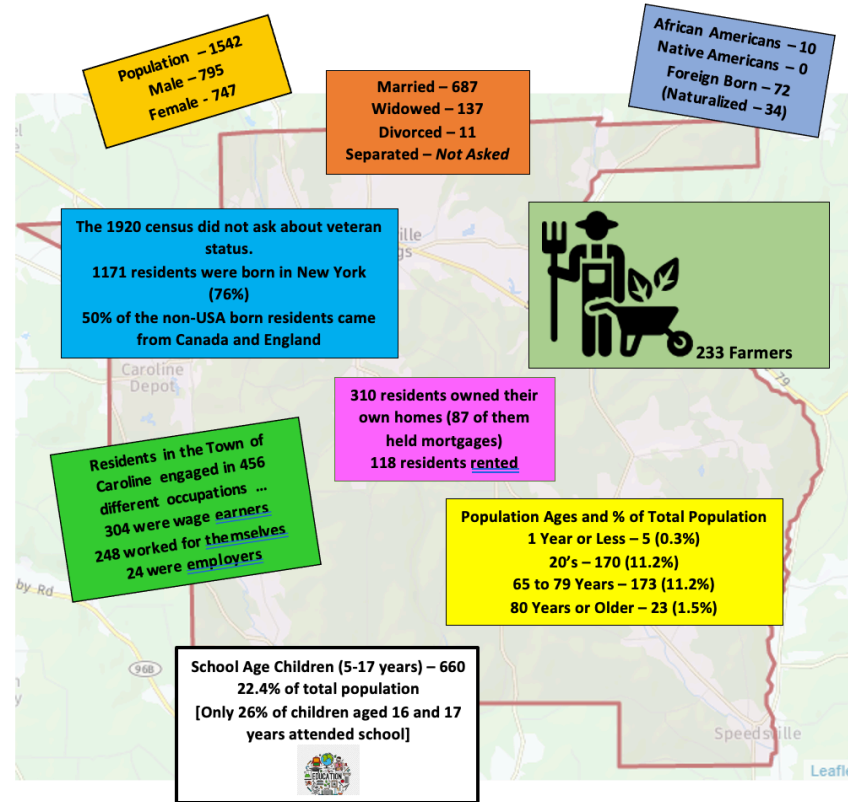

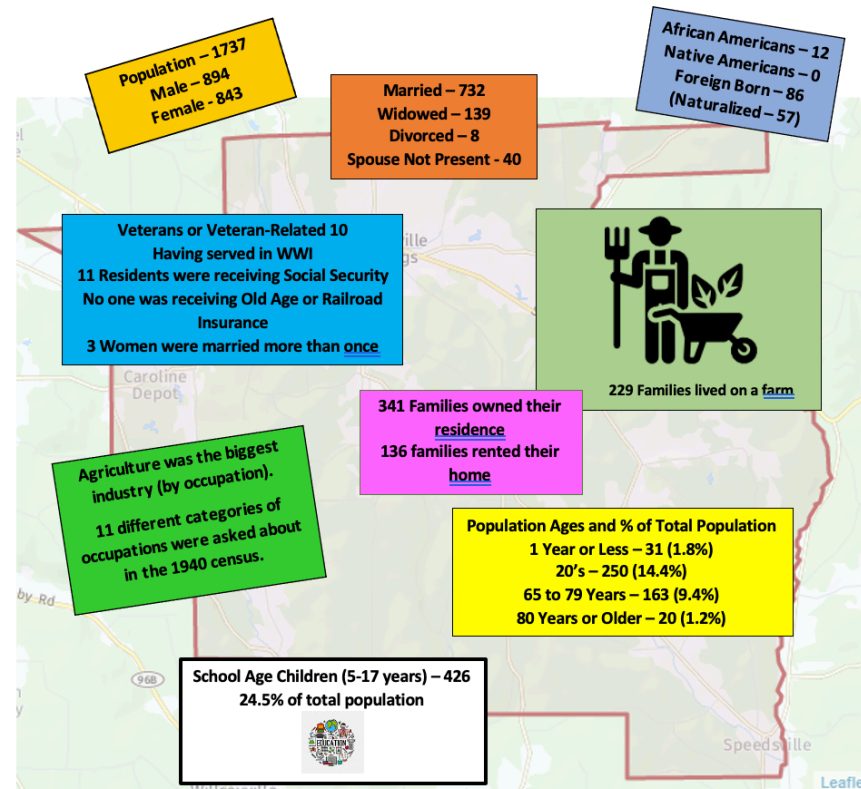


## A SNAPSHOT OF LIFE IN THE TOWN OF CAROLINE FROM 1920 CENSUS DATA



1920 census enumerators in the Town of Caroline were Charles H. Bogardus and Hubert A. Whittaker. House numbering did not occur until 1957; road names were infrequently mentioned. Data was transcribed exactly as the enumerators had written; the quality of handwriting sometimes made it very difficult to figure out names. Searches on Ancestry and Find-A-Grave were often used to confirm correct spelling.

## A SNAPSHOT OF LIFE IN THE TOWN OF CAROLINE FROM 1940 CENSUS DATA



1940 Census enumerator in the Town of Caroline was Jessie Townsend. House numbering did not occur until 1957; areas of the Town of Caroline were identified as “Unincorporated Place” – Brooktondale, etc. Sometimes street names were given. 3 men were identified as being part of the CCC (as a separate enumeration district). Data was transcribed exactly as the enumerators had written.

## A SNAPSHOT OF LIFE IN THE TOWN OF CAROLINE FROM 1950 CENSUS DATA



1950 Census enumerators in the Town of Caroline were Phyllis Whittaker and Elsie English. House numbering did not occur until 1957; residence locations were often mentioned as “3<sup>rd</sup> house from the corner” or by other similar identifying comments. Data was transcribed exactly as the enumerators had written.
